




Corte Tegge



HISTORY OF CAVRIAGO



Resistance et anti-fascism

Cavriago has a long anti-fascist tradition. The town was awarded a bronze medal for the Resistance, as 223 Cavriago partisans fought against the Fascist dictatorship during the Second World War.



Historical notes

After being a possession of Matilde de Canossa, the town became a border territory between the duchies of Parma and Modena. Divided in two, it was one of the first places of insurrection in favour of national unity during the Risorgimento.
